Where	Riccarton Bush between Kahu Road and Ngahere Street
When	Monday 18 September 2017

What has been completed:

- The **shared pathway** through Riccarton Bush
- New **carpark** and **driveway** was also constructed at Riccarton Bush



Things to note:

- **Establishment of new grass** – areas along the sides of the path will stay taped off while new grass is growing. Please be respectful of these areas, the barriers will be removed at the discretion of the Riccarton Bush rangers.
- **Increased numbers of cyclists and pedestrians** – as the shared pathway reopens, expect higher numbers of users traveling along the Uni-Cycle link.

Cyclists, please moderate your speeds when travelling along the Riccarton Bush shared pathway.
- **Fresh seal on driveway and carpark** – when driving into Riccarton Bush avoid heavy turning or braking as the new seal sets.
- **Riccarton House, Local and the Farmer's Markets remain open for business as usual** – moving into spring and summer be mindful of increased visitors to Riccarton House and Riccarton Bush.
